

## **RESERVA**

TYPE: Aged red wine.

VARIETIES: 95% Tempranillo, 5% Mazuelo.

**AREA:** Rioja Alta. **D.O.:** D.O.Ca. Rioja.

PRODUCER: Hacienda El Ternero.

VINEYARDS: 60 Has. Own vineyards surrounding the winery.

KIND OF BOTTLE: Bourgogne. BOTTLE VOLUME: 75 cl. ALCOHOL: 13,5 % vol.

## WINEMAKING AND AGEING

After the manual harvest, the maceration of this wine usually takes about 15-20 days. After this time, 60% of the wine undergoes malolactic fermentation in new French oak barrels, while the remaining 40% do so in barrels of second use. After malolactic fermentation, the wine grew up in the same barrels for 18 or 20 months.

## WINE TASTING

Cherry red color with an aromatic component in which the berries such as blackberries and blueberries predominate, all assembled with spicy aromas and vanilla coming from the oak.

The palate is fresh and round, recalling flavors of black fruit and spice scrub.
