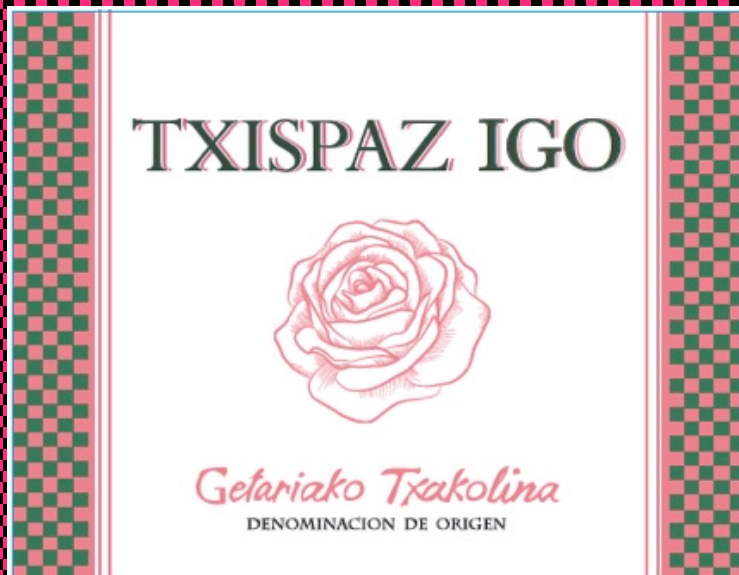


TXISPAZ IGO 2016 GETARIAKO TXAKOLINA



NON-TECHNICAL & ALTERNATIVE FACTS

Cultivar: 100% Hondarribi Beltza - REAL Beltza, not the all too common trucked in Garnacha from La Mancha variety that some producers use, but the real deal. Less than 4% of Txakolina plantings are, in fact, Beltza, one of the rarest red wine varieties in the world. How can that one producer (you know their name...) make all that Rose, you ask? Spain's freeway system is the answer.

Alcohol: If this sheet's background is still annoying you, keep drinking! The wine is 11% by volume so you are probably going to need the entire bottle. Please, be responsible. If you drink enough and you stare long enough at this sheet, you might see one of those hidden images. Please let us know if you do, we can't find it.

Oak: There is a big oak tree right by the winery providing shade, but no trees were harmed in the making of this wine.

Chimparta: (Bubbles) are about a 8.1 on scale of 1-10, that we just made up. The Russian judge only gave it a 2, however.
